



The **University of South Florida (USF)** is approximately 14 miles from the Tampa International Airport which equates to a 20 to 30 minute drive, depending on traffic conditions. Upon exiting the Tampa International Airport, follow the signs for I-275 Northbound and use the directions listed below.

USF campus address is 4202 E. Fowler Ave, Tampa, FL 33620

CUTR's physical address is 3808 Alumni Drive, Tampa, FL 33620

To Reach the USF Campus from I-275 Northbound

Exit at Fowler Avenue and turn right onto Fowler. The campus is about 4 miles east of the I-275 exit. Turn left onto USF's main entrance (*Leroy Collins Blvd*). Turn left at the first traffic signal onto *USF Alumni Drive*. CUTR is the 2-story building located on the right between the Richard A. Beard parking garage and the College of Engineering II building.

To Reach the USF Campus from I-75 Northbound

Exit at Fowler Avenue West, heading toward the University of South Florida/Temple Terrace. The campus is about 4 miles west of the I-75 exit. Turn right into USF's main entrance (*Leroy Collins Blvd*). Turn left at the first traffic signal onto *USF Alumni Drive*. CUTR is the 2-story building located on the right between the Richard A. Beard parking garage and the College of Engineering II building.

To Reach the USF Campus from I-75 Southbound

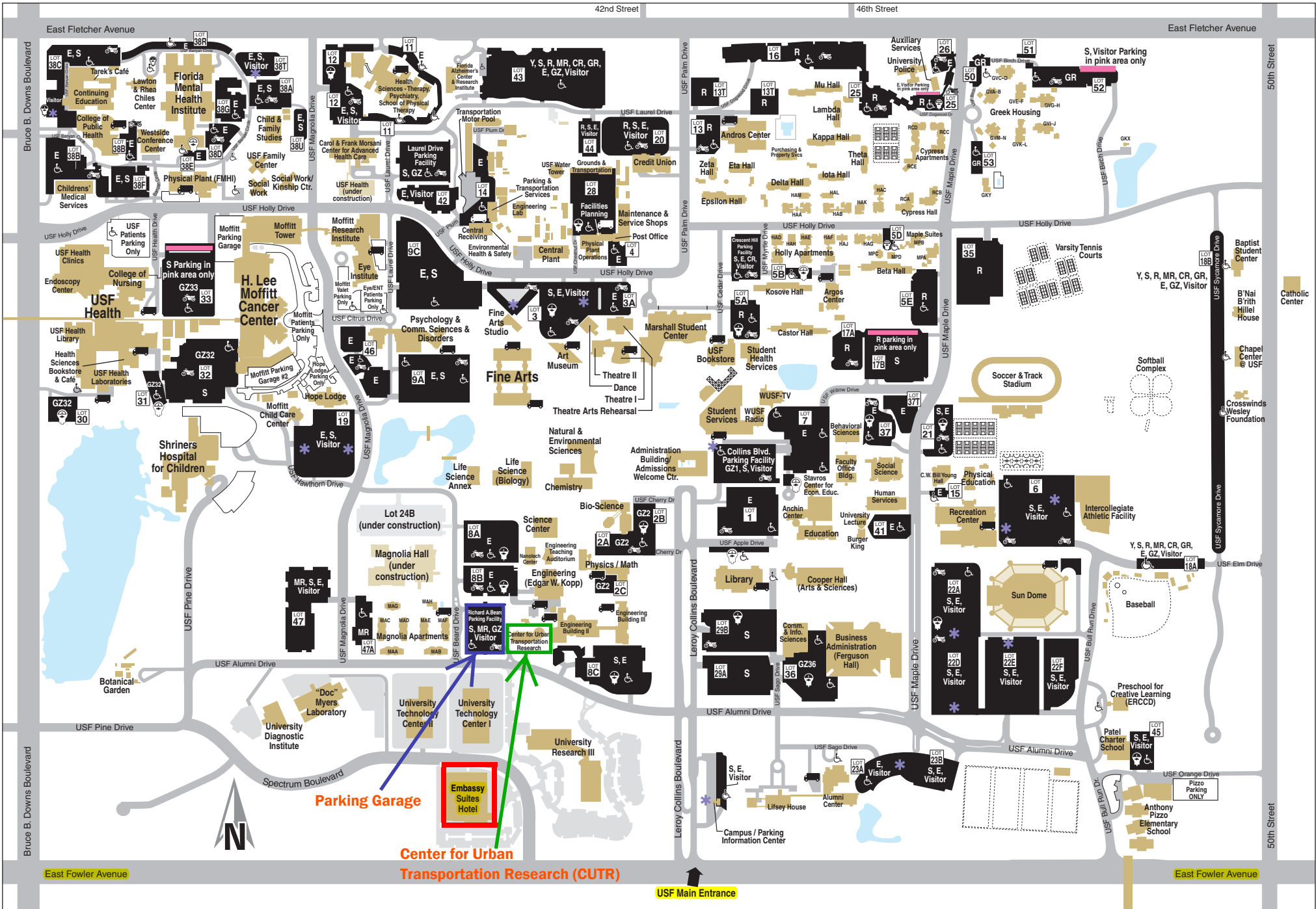

To Reach the USF Campus from I-4 Westbound

Merge onto I-75 North. Exit at Fowler Avenue West. The campus is about 4 miles west of the I-75 exit. Turn right into USF's main entrance (*Leroy Collins Blvd*). Turn left at the first traffic signal onto *USF Alumni Drive*. CUTR is the 2-story building located on the right between the Richard A. Beard parking garage and the College of Engineering II building.

Parking Information

From *USF Alumni Drive*, turn right into the Richard A. Beard parking garage and park in Visitor Parking on floors 4 through 8. A parking pass is required to park in the Beard parking garage on weekdays. Parking passes will be distributed on Sunday, December 13 at the Center for Urban Transportation Research (CUTR) building. Scratch off the date information on the parking pass and hang it from the rearview mirror with the USF logo facing out, in plain view. **If you are staying at the Embassy Suites, it is an easy walk to USF-CUTR. They also offer an on-campus shuttle if you prefer.*

USF Wireless Guest Access

Wireless access is provided to guests of USF who do not have a NetID. Please follow the instructions below to connect to the Guest Wireless network. This process will work on all devices, including mobile devices.

1. Please open your list of wireless connections, and select "USF-Guest".
2. Once you are connected to USF-Guest, please open your web browser and attempt to navigate to a website. You will be automatically redirected to our Guest Registration page.
3. Once you have successfully navigated to the Guest Registration page, please select your preferred method of contact, whether "Call me on the phone" or "Send me a text message".
4. After a short waiting period, <5 minutes, you will receive a temporary access code. Please select the option 'I have my access code'. You will need to agree to the acceptable use policy to continue.
5. Enter your mobile phone number, and the Registration code you received and hit 'submit'.
6. You are now connected to USF-Guest. This registration will last for 24 hours, and is valid for 1 device.
